Look to the Stars

Just like Maui, you have learned to look to the stars to plan your savings journey. Now let's practice!

Help Moana complete a star plan for her whānau, then make one for your own whānau's goal!



Moana, her sister Mariah, mother, and father want to go to the movies to see the new Marvel film. They want to go to the fancy screening with lounge chairs and food included.

★ Fill out Moana's goal - **Goal**

Tickets for the whānau are \$50 with a booking fee of \$6.60.

Moana and Mariah know what they want to eat - the Luxury Food package for 4, at \$220. It has salad wraps, drinks, fruit and popcorn.

★ Fill out the total cost - **Cost**





The whānau talk about how to earn pūtea for the movie night.

Mum will take an extra piano ākonga and contribute half the lesson earnings (\$25) each fortnight.

Dad says he is very busy and can't work any extra jobs but will match Mum's \$25 per fortnight.

Mariah offers to walk local dogs. She will earn \$10 a week. Mariah will keep \$5 for her own savings and contribute \$5.

Moana sells a scooter that she's outgrown. It's in good condition and her friend will pay \$50 for it. She will contribute \$25 and save \$25.

- ★ Fill out how the whānau will earn their movie pūtea - **Ways to Earn**
- ★ Fill out how much pūtea the whānau will earn per week by adding up the different amounts - **Money earned per week**
- ★ Fill out how much pūtea Moana and Mariah will save for other goals, and cannot contribute to the movies - **Money saved per week**
- ★ Work out how many weeks it would take the whānau to save up - **Weeks until goal achieved**

TIP: Take away the once-off amount that Moana's scooter will contribute, then divide the remaining goal amount by the weekly contribution of the whānau.

This will tell you how many weeks the whānau should save for.

Moana and her whānau decide to save their pūtea for the movies in a pūtea box on top of the fridge. They stick a picture of the movie poster to the fridge to remind them of their goal.

When the next kura holidays come, Moana and her whānau are off to the movies!
